Referral processes

Paediatric allergy clinics

We hold paediatric allergy clinics at both North Tyneside and Wansbeck general hospitals for children under 16 years of age.

You can refer patients in for concerns about IgE mediated allergy (food or respiratory, including rhinitis and urticaria) but also for non-IgE mediated allergy where there are concerns about growth faltering, multiple food intolerances or other red flags (as per NICE guidance).

Dr Mairi Woodsford holds clinics at North Tyneside every Monday afternoon and Dr Ivonne Haar's clinics are held on Tuesday afternoons at Wansbeck. They can perform skin prick testing and/or specific IgE blood testing, and there is a dietitian available at the clinics for advice on allergen avoidance and other nutritional issues.

These clinics are on e-Referral.

Direct access to plain film x-ray

Our radiology service is improving access for patients referred by their GP for a plain film x-ray. From 1 November, all GP direct access x-ray referrals requested on ICE will be allowed four weeks from the referral date to attend as a walk-in patient or by booking an appointment.

Please refer suitable patients into direct access x-ray rather than through urgent care.

Once referred, patients can call 0191 293 4122 to book an appointment (line open Monday to Friday 9am-7pm and weekends 9am-12 midday).

- Hexham General Hospital -; Monday to Friday 9am-4.30pm then appointment only between 5.30pm-7.30pm. Weekends by appointment only 11am-;1pm then 2pm-; 5pm
